- Each RSU represents the right to receive, following vesting, 1 Ordinary Share held in the form of an ADS.
- This RSU award was granted on May 1, 2025. 30% will vest on each of May 15, 2026 and May 15, 2027, and the remaining 40% will vest on May 15, 2028, subject to continued service to the Company.
- This RSU award of 15,490 was granted on May 13, 2024, of which 30% already vested on May 15, 2025. 30% will vest on May 15, 2026 and 40% will vest on May 15, 2027, subject to continued service to the Company.
